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Editor's Note

52.5% of 3DX Chat players maintain at least one alt. Here's why I don't.

Very few people just are what they are. Most of us, the vast majority in fact, express very different versions of ourselves depending on where we are and who we're with. Odds are you behave differently with your friends than you do with your boss. Your parents than you do with a sibling. When you're alone than when you're in public. Only those who are supremely confident, utterly callous or socially clueless behave in a perfectly consistent manner in all company.

Not many people would say that a person is being "fake" by treating their spouse differently than, say, a co-worker. And that's because we recognize that there are unwritten rules when it comes to behaving appropriately, and ignoring them can have very significant social, and even legal, repercussions.

Having a presence in a virtual world requires us to have an avatar, and seeing as we find ourselves in a whole new social situation when online it's not surprising that most of us behave differently in a virtual environment than we might in the real world. It's not an issue of being "fake"—merely a normal adjustment we make, just as we do in every other facet of our lives.

So far I think most people with any online experience would agree with me. But what about alts? Without a doubt there are several completely justifiable reasons to have an alternate identity online, such as privacy concerns or to better enjoy an ongoing roleplay. But establishing a serious, separate, secondary online identity does seem a bit... dubious. At least to me.

In the last issue of Cybersex magazine we learned that only 47.5% of 3DX players *don't* have any alts, meaning that the majority do. And even if we write off half of those cases as being avatars used for "legitimate" purposes, that still leaves over a thousand other alts roaming the game.

Within this issue you'll find the article "In Defense of Alts" by DarkAmber, which offers some interesting psychological and sociological perspectives on this phenomenon, and that spurred me to consider why I make the personal choice not to maintain an alt.

For me, the relationships I have online are tremendously important. I don't have "online friends". They're simply friends. I don't have "online lovers". They're lovers, pure and simple. And though I understand there's always likely to be a significant difference between our avatars and our real life selves, to me there's a profound honesty you can encounter online that you rarely find in the real world.

I have had gentlemen share kinks with me in 3DX that they've never mentioned to their wives in decades of marriage. Had people tell me stories about their hopes and dreams that they'd never shared with those closest to them in the real world. Had people open up to me about unpopular religious and political beliefs that they'd normally never express for fear of ridicule and ostracization.

I treasure and respect those glimpses people allow me of their truest, most vulnerable selves. And in reciprocation I desire to be as real as I can with everyone I meet online. Maybe my avatar is analogous to a mask I wear, but at least I always wear the same one, and I hope that inspires the trust and intimacy I treasure.



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Surviving a Virtual Breakup

I've always taken issue with the term "virtual relationship", as I've found it to be very misleading. Yes, some relationships are between ourselves and people we've met online, and in that regard they're virtual. You Have to Grieve

Your ex might have been the worst person in the world, treating you awfully and making you downright despise them. Yet regardless of that it's still natural to mourn when you lose someone, and that's doubly true when they were a perfectly good person, but things simply didn't work out.

Well meaning friends might try to dismiss your feelings for your ex as being foolish, and encourage you to simply shut them out of your heart and move on. But the fact remains that your ex and you shared good moments, and for a time they had a special place in your life. So don't fight the impulse to grieve, and don't beat yourself up about missing someone even if they treated you badly.

Grief is essential to the healing process, and trying to skip past it will do more harm than good in the long run. It might even affect your ability to have positive relationships in the future as buried pain never has a chance to truly dissipate.

You're Going to be Lonely

The result won't be anything positive.

If you're hunting around the virtual world looking for them you're going to appear crazy or creepy or both, and it'll be even worse if you find them. After all, what are you going to say that doesn't sound desperate?

Instead, write down what you want to say to your ex, then put it away in a drawer for a few days before revisiting it. Odds are excellent that when you read what you wrote you'll end up thinking, "Oh thank goodness I didn't talk to them. That sounds so stupid."

You'll Grow as a Person

Yes, breakups are the worst. But once you get through them and look back, you'll see that they're also kind of the best things that can happen to you.

Breakups allow you to learn what you want out of life and teach you about who you are. They give you the strength to deal with loss gracefully, and open a path to better, deeper, more meaningful relationships that your old ones could never have been.

In short, breakups are some of the key defining moments in our lives. Seize that opportunity to grow.

You'll Bounce Back

An Alien Mind

People roleplay all kinds of non-humans online. Everything from elves to orcs, demons to werewolves and vampires to nekos. And perhaps the choices listed above are so popular because they're all well-known and defined, courtesy of pop culture.

But what if you want to roleplay something that's not so human? What if you want to roleplay something a bit more... alien?

Well, the obvious choice is to do just that: roleplay another species from the depths of space. And there's certainly plenty of those available off the proverbial shelf. Well-developed alien species like Vulcans and Asari are abundant, but you run into the issue of simply roleplaying what someone else imagined, as with the other races or species mentioned above.

And that's a shame, because most of the fun that comes from roleplaying isn't merely rehashing the old, but creating and exploring the new. By taking the time to craft your own species, you have a tremendous opportunity to exercise your creativity, while giving others the chance to interact, both socially and sexually, with a being they have no idea what to expect from.

Yes, there will be people only interested in your alien because they want the novelty of fucking someone with blue skin. Or those who've watched a few too many hentai videos and want to play "naughty tentacles".

But there will also be those who want to engage in erotic roleplay that's as intellectual and philosophical as it is exotic, and this article is your guide to enabling those kind of wonderful close encounters.

Building from the Inside Out

The first thing you need to consider when developing an alien species is how you're going to craft a character you not only *can* roleplay, but will really *want* to roleplay.

And to do that, you need to start with who *you* are as a person. What are your interests? Your values? Your





beliefs? Your fears and desires? Your kinks?

Begin by writing down a few of your own key traits, until you have a brief description of who you are as a person. An example of such a list might look something like this...

- Pacifist
- Environmentalist
- Animal Lover
- Enjoys Trance Music
- Loves the Beach
- Dislikes Crowds
- Nudist
- Loves Oral Sex

You know you can roleplay as a being that has those traits because you *are* a being that has those traits, so your performance is going to be highly convincing. But the next question is *why* your alien is like that, and that's where the creative process can get really interesting.

As an example, let's begin with the "pacifist" trait

listed above. There are many reasons an alien might have a strong aversion to war, be it historical, psychological or cultural.

It could be that their species were once brought to the brink of extinction through a nuclear conflict, and the experience made them adamant to never repeat the same horrifying mistake.

It could be that they evolved from a prey species both highly docile and empathic, and thus find the very thought of violence nauseating. The idea of hurting another being might seem just as bad to them as getting hurt themselves. Perhaps even worse.

It could be that they're a species that sees violence as great, but only in the context of fair and honorable combat. They might have an utterly blood drenched culture full of deadly duels and elaborate death sports, but never engage in war because they consider it cowardly and barbaric.

And of course, there are a hundred other reasons an alien might be a pacifist. You don't need to start off by detailing some huge and elaborate history, but it's a good idea to lay out the broad brushstrokes of why

your alien is the way he/she/it is. Work through your traits, and come up with creative reasons behind each.

Physiology & Sexuality

3DX Chat is a sex game, and as such, a large component of roleplaying an alien is going to revolve around getting busy. To make that interesting and realistic, it's important to consider your alien's physiology.

Are they warm or cold-blooded? Do they have two biological genders like humans, or more, or fewer? Do they give birth to live young, or lay eggs, or reproduce by some other means? Are they rather human-like because of convergent evolution, or do they only appear that way because they have technology that hides their true form? Do they get pleasure out of sex in the same way humans do, or do they have special erogenous zones / mating habits?

What does your alien's skin and hair feel like? What's their scent? Are they soft and cuddly or aggressive and rough? All this will play into the descriptions you use when engaged in affection, foreplay and cybersex.

Which of course brings about the question of why an alien might want to have sex with a human to begin with, which in turn opens up many more interesting possibilities.

While it's incredibly unlikely that any alien species would ever naturally be able to interbreed with humans in the conventional sense, that doesn't mean there aren't any possibilities in that regard. An alien, for example, might implant an egg into a host which remains warm and protected inside their body until ready to hatch. They might have undergone genetic modification which made them reproductively compatible with humans before arriving on Earth. Or they may have sperm which, rather than combining with the genetic material in a human egg, simply overwrites it entirely, thus using the human host to grow a clone of the father.

Then, of course, there's the possibility that an alien

wouldn't care about breeding whatsoever, and merely wants to have recreational sex for the simple pleasure of it. In fact, making love to a human might be preferable to having sex with one of their own kind, for the simple reason that not only is there zero chance of an unplanned pregnancy, but human STDs do not affect them.

Whatever the case, sex may be extremely casual in an alien culture, or seen as an important part of establishing positive relations with other sentient species. It might have special cultural or religious significance, or may be something that your alien views as utterly normal and mundane as yawning.


By putting a bit of thought into what sex is like with your alien, and what motivates them to have it, you have the opportunity to treat your partners to a potentially amazing sexual experience. After all, with everything being new and exciting, and your partner not quite knowing what to expect, having sex with an alien can be like being a virgin again. And how fun is that!

Alien Improv

There are endless things to consider when roleplaying a realistic and exciting extraterrestrial, but that doesn't mean you need to write an encyclopedia about your interstellar species before you begin. Part of the joy of roleplay is the improvisation—simply making things up as you go along and then figuring them out later.

As such, it's important to enter the game with an open mind, and just be willing to let your imagination run wild. Roleplayed conversations can result in all kinds of questions you didn't anticipate, thus giving you the opportunity to explore and develop your character over time.

If someone, for example, asks what your character's home world is like, just take the first thing that pops into your head and go from there.



Maybe your alien's home is much like Earth. Maybe it's a vast, planet-spanning city. Maybe it's an emerald desert dotted with bejewelled oases, a volcanic jungle filled with carnivorous plants or a global ocean strung with endless archipelagos of pearlescent sand. Maybe your alien doesn't even have a home planet, but grew up onboard a spaceship, their species' original home world left behind so many generations ago so as to have been completely forgotten.

Whatever answer you give becomes a springboard to the next question, thus entertaining both you and the people you roleplay with.

Design Your Playscape

Not everyone is a great builder, but if you happen to have some skills in that department, don't be shy to create an environment to complement your alien. This could take the form of a starship, a "holodeck" or a distant world, to which your alien has the ability to teleport their lovers.

As you create, you'll find that your build starts to shape your alien's story, and vice-versa, making for an even more interesting experience for those lucky enough to roleplay with you.

World builder is filled with a fantastic range of textures, shapes and colors to experiment with, and by letting your imagination run wild you may find there's a huge payoff in the experiences you'll get to share.

Ideas are Everywhere

Looking for inspiration? Science fiction is filled with countless examples of alien species, from the virtually human to those barely recognizable as even being alive. And the more you read and watch, the more ideas you can fashion, modify or just plain steal to help make your character more interesting.

In fact, there's an amazing series of videos on YouTube which thoroughly explores dozens of alien species from fiction, while providing science-backed speculation regarding who may be coming to visit us!



The Joy of (Alien) Sex

No matter what type of species you design, you'll find that the process can be amazingly fun, the interactions awesome and the cybersex incredible—but only if you can find the right lovers to enjoy the experience with.

So even if you're just playing a regular old human on 3dxChat, don't be shy when you see an alien avatar online. Odds are good that person has put a lot of thought into the persona they've created, and if you have an open mind you might find getting to know them highly rewarding. After all, the friendship, flirting and sex are all, quite literally, out of this world!

Gyn-Chair With Anal Beads by Veronique





The People of World Chat

The Good, the Bad and the Weird of 3DX. By JamieSweet

Imagine a never-ending highway lined with billboards, each informing you of another fun adult attraction available at the next turnoff. Great clubs. Awesome events. Sexy escorts. Spectacular nude beaches.

But billboards aren't the only things that can be found down this particular stretch of asphalt.

There's also some incredibly considerate people who volunteer their time to help new travelers, incredibly nasty people who throw bricks at your car if you so much as look at them funny, and straight-up weirdos who would like to talk to you about joining a religion based entirely on bacon.

That's World Chat in a nutshell, which is why the vast majority of 3DX players either never visit it, or drive fast with the doors locked and windows rolled up.

The Good

If you observe World Chat long enough you'll see that there are some truly friendly and helpful people there, such as DevilInside and SkyLynx.

They're the ones who reach out and help new players looking for direction, providing the closest thing 3DX has to in-game customer support. They're also the ones who help spread useful news about updates, glitches and upcoming features, helping to keep the rank and file players informed of such things.

In short they provide a very useful service to the game, and they do so consistently, kindly and despite the insanity (and sometimes outright abuse) they're endlessly bombarded with by other world chat

denizens. In short, they're the unsung heroes of 3DX Chat, and I salute them.

The Bad

While World Chat features some of the nicest people in the game, it also features some of the worst, and I'm not talking about entertaining 4-Chan style trolling or people merely being politically incorrect. I'm talking about players who are really, really, *really* horrible human beings.

They seem to endlessly heap raw, hateful abuse on anyone and everyone, squealing delusional selfaggrandizement between outpourings of pure vitriol. No doubt they've already been ignored by literally hundreds of other players, and as they're completely incapable of obtaining good attention they rage and provoke in a frantic effort to get the bad kind.



World Chat in a nutshell.

I'm not going to name names for two simple reasons. The first is that their behavior instantly identifies them. The second is that I seriously believe at least a couple of them are mentally ill, and certainly shouldn't be encouraged to pursue their mindless selfdestruction online. These people have my pity, though not to the degree that I'd ever want to deal with them.

The Weird

Once you place the maniacs on ignore, there is a third type of World Chat habitué that quickly becomes apparent—and those are the weirdos.

Without a doubt most of these are normal people with an offbeat sense of humor, killing time by teasing and bamboozling their fellow players with a river of nonsense.

And then there's a few, such as Neolithic, who have been going on and on with their particular brand of strangeness so long that you have to wonder if they are, in fact, quite mad (though in the nicest possible way).

Here are just a few gems of history and wisdom I was able to pick up from him...

"3DX used to be more social. Sure, some people hated me because I'm a lawn tractor and because I brought the Word of the Swine to the people. Still, for the most part people loved the swine and the swine loved them."

Conclusion

World Chat is probably the most often ignored, yet strangest virtual ecosystem in 3DX Chat. In other games moderators would have long ago sterilized it into a bland stream of small talk, but in the quasianarchistic environment allowed by the 3DX developers something way more interesting has developed: a kind of collective stream of consciousness made up of the very best, and worst, and colorful minds.

So the next time you're driving down that proverbial highway, consider pulling over and visiting with the locals. You might meet a super nice person, get screamed at by a raging lunatic, or get lectured on the benefits of an all-bacon diet.

But you sure as heck won't be bored.

I Don't Pay For It

The sad misconception men have about 3DX escorts. By JamieSweet

Some men on 3DX don't employ escorts, and that's fine.

Everyone has their preferences, and I'd never shame anyone for not being into escorts any more than I would hassle them for hiring one. What's interesting, though, is that that when I've asked such men *why* they don't, I've invariably gotten the same answer again and again and again.

And that answer has been that they want the women they sleep with to genuinely desire them—not do it merely because they were paid to. These men don't want to be "tolerated". They don't want to "force" themselves on girls. They simply want the sex they have, be it a meaningless quickie or a months long relationship, to be mutually desired.

These are decent, caring men, and I can understand and sympathize with the sentiment, but there's a very important factor that they miss, and it's costing them a lot of truly wonderful experiences they could be having.

She's a fellow player with a very special kink and fantasy, and if you think a she plays with just *anyone* you're mistaken. The reason a 3DX escort will even accept a man's gifts in the first place is because of two main reasons.

The first is that he's showing a genuine interest in her kink. Rather than handwaving it away, he's effectively saying, "I know you have this fantasy, and I want to help you make it happen." Rather than merely trying to talk his way into her panties, he's showing he has both the confidence and consideration to indulge her sexuality, and is willing to roleplay her favorite scenario with her.

Secondly, he's showing her real respect. Treating her as an equal. He's recognizing that she's not some mindless fairy tale damsel in distress, nor some desperate victim whoring herself to feed her children. She's a human being who is using 3DX to explore and indulge her fantasies, and who is eager to enter into a deeply mutual exchange of sexual excitement.

3DX escorts play with the men who hire them because those men are overwhelmingly confident, considerate and respectful which, by the way, is pretty much the perfect recipe for a fantastic lover.

Go try and hire an escort while behaving rude and boorish, and you'll quickly find there's not enough gifts in the virtual world to buy one second of her time, let alone an hour. The reason a 3DX escort asks for symbolic payment is because it's part of her fantasy, not because she's somehow going to pay her mortgage by having a few more gifts on her profile.

So the next time you're feeling a little lonely or bored, and would like to enjoy an evening with a smart, sexy, confident lover, consider treating both yourself, and her, to the experience.

You'll soon discover what so many players on 3DX already have, and that's that a night with a virtual escort may be one of the richest, and most intimate, sexual experiences you ever have online.

In Defence of Alts

Most 3DX Chat players have alts, and there's good (and bad) reasons for that. By DarkAmber

In the October issue of Cybersex, Jamie Sweet published a short article called *3DX By The Numbers* in which she shared a bunch of random figures pertaining to the game and it's players. One of those numbers was 45.7.

That's the percentage of players who, according to her research, don't have any alts. That must mean that 54.3% do, and that having an alt on 3DX Chat isn't the exception. It's the rule.

So why does the term have such a negative connotation?

Why Alts Matter

When we play 3DX Chat, or any online game for that matter, we have an identity we project. The way our avatar looks. The contents of our profile. The places we frequent. The people on our friends list. They all make up who we are online and, very importantly, how others come to know and relate to us.

Because most people online aren't sociopaths, we develop genuine feelings for each other. Make friendships and connections. And anytime you open yourself up to that you're also opening yourself up to getting hurt. How an alt is used can either enhance or harm your relationships. Build amazing intimacy, or destroy all trust.

So let's take a look at both the good and bad ways in which alts are employed, and examine just why so many players, including myself, choose to have at least one.

Reason One: Privacy

Most serious builders on 3DX maintain an alt simply so that they can work without interruption. Sure you could slap up an "AFK" sign as your profile picture, but not only is it easy to forget to do that, but people invariably miss it and message you anyway. The friendless alt is simply a great way to work in peace, and without the risk of hurting anyone's feelings when their messages get missed because you have the chat window minimized.

Similarly, I know several couples who have alts which only they know about. A special secret they share so that they can meet online and enjoy a few hours of sweet, uninterrupted intimacy together.

Both of these, to my way of thinking, are fantastic uses of alts as they allow players to step back from the "always on" existence many of us have online, and just focus on our creativity and deepest, most important relationships.

Reason Two: Adultery

Marital infidelity is a dicey prospect if you don't have an alt. Not only could you be seen with someone you're not supposed to be with, but even if you stay away from prying eyes it's only a matter of time before your significant other comes online unexpectantly and interrupts your liaison.

Plus more than one cheating spouse has been caught thanks to a well intentioned gift left on their profile, or been exposed by the very person they were cheating with when the affair turned sour.



And that's not even including the fact that, without an alt, the object of your desire may simply refuse to participate in adultery with you. If you're interested in sleeping with your husband's best friend or wife's sister, an alt may literally be the only way to make that happen.

So, for all these reasons and more, why *wouldn't* you use an alt if you're planning to cheat? It's the virtual equivalent of "Sorry, Dear, but I had to work late at the office again".

Understand, I'm not condoning this practice. Merely

saying that it's definitely part of the dark side of alts, and it's naïve to think that some married people especially those in exclusive relationships—don't maintain a separate identity for just this purpose.

Reason Three: Experimentation

Recently, a male friend I've known on 3DX for more than two years made a confession to me: He not only had a secret alt, and not only was that alt female, but that female just happened to be one of my closest associates.

I felt hurt and angry and betrayed, but for the sake of the years of our friendship and the fact that he was voluntarily coming clean about his deception, I was willing to sit down and listen as too why he'd been maintaining a second identity—and for so long.

The answer surprised me.

First off, he explained that he'd never had sex with his alt. Never entered into any relationship beyond friendship. And that he'd never abused his alt by asking anyone about himself. And all that, to the best of my knowledge, was completely true.

The reason he occasionally used this alt was because he wanted to understand women better. To gain some perspective not just on our in-game experience, but to see what we talked about when there were no men around. How we interacted in their friendships. What we really thought about certain topics and issues.

And he reported that over two years of using his alt a day or two a week, he'd really come to learn a huge amount about what made women tick—and that had forced him to seriously re-examine many of his own beliefs as a man.

The reason he was taking off his mask with me was because he felt he'd learned all that he could, and that he wanted to share what had been an amazing and enlightening experience with me as a friend.

Some would say that what my friend did was wrong,

and to be blunt I'd be one of them. But I did understand and appreciate his curiosity, and I was glad that the experience had benefited both him and the women in his life. And I doubt very much that he's the first person to do something like this.

I'd be amazed if there weren't black people walking around in white avatars, or women in male ones—or vice versa—but not out of a desire to deceive. Human beings are curious by nature, and alts are most certainly used to learn and experiment.

Reason Four: Hiding in the Closet

One look at porn will reveal that woman have pretty much 100% social licence to be bi or homosexual, and in my experience at least half the women on 3DX have had at least one sexual encounter with another female.

Guys are a whole other story.

Even in the hyper-permissive world of 3DX Chat, masculinity can be surprisingly fragile, and a guy with gay or bisexual leanings might find it very awkward to come out of the closet, just as they might in real life.

So it shouldn't be surprising that some men might choose to sport a transsexual or female avatar so that they can indulge their desires on occasion, while maintaining their regular male identity most of the time.

Is that deceptive? Perhaps even predatory? I would say so. Especially when you're using such an alt to have sex with men who you know don't want to engage in homosexual behavior.

But then again perhaps such an alt might serve as a stepping stone—a path by which they can get comfortable with their sexuality and finally make the choice to get out of the closet.

It's complicated, and another an instance in which an alt could be considered both good and bad.

Reason Five: Roleplay

There are those who choose to roleplay fictional characters on 3DX, such as elves, vampires, nekos or aliens. Even futanari could be argued to fall into this category. And for such players a huge amount of their fun comes from the opportunity to step out of their own skins for an evening and be someone else.

Having an alt can allow a person to put on a virtual costume and go incognito, acting and exploring their chosen role without having to break character. And, in my opinion, these alts inject a playful dose of the weird and wonderful into 3DX.

Without them, the place would be a lot less interesting.

Reason Six: Spying

Would your spouse cheat on you if given the chance? Does your best friend really like you, or are they just pretending so as to stay part of your social circle? Just what does your boyfriend get up to when you're not online? What does your girlfriend have to say about you when your metaphorical back is turned?

Relationships on 3DX can be every bit as meaningful at real life ones, and so can the insecurities that come with them. Many of us have wondered the same or similar things as listed above, and for some the temptation to go "undercover" to find answers results in

them creating alts specifically to spy on friends or significant others.

In some cases this could be seen as justified, just as hiring a private detective in real life might be. But at least as often, it stems from a neurotic obsession with loyalty or control, and isn't healthy for anyone.

That said, relationships are huge part of 3DX for many players, and most of us harbor insecurities of one kind or another. For better or for worse, the game of love may be rife with espionage online.

Reason Seven: A Fresh Start

There are those on 3DX who, for lack of a better word, have messed up. They've burned bridges with people they've cared about. Gotten entangled in dramas they hate. Been caught in lies which have ruined their reputations. And though they may deeply regret their past actions, there's not too much they can do about it.

Except create an alt and start over with a new identity, of course.

There are many in the history of 3DX who have phased out of one persona and into another, so as to reestablish themselves after a catastrophic social blunder, and it would surprise me if a large percentage of 3DX's players aren't on their second (or third) incarnations. And once again, depending on the situation, this use of alts could be considered good or bad.

Being able to start again under a virtual "witness pro-

tection program" gives a person a chance to learn from their mistakes and become a better, kinder, wiser individual.

It also, unfortunately, gives really unpleasant people a chance to escape the social repercussions of their actions and continue behaving abysmally—thus enabling the worst trolls and sociopaths in the game.

Final Thoughts

I am the first to acknowledge that there are a lot of ways in which alts are a bad thing for 3DX, and without argument their use is regularly abused. But I titled my article "In Defence of Alts" because there are at least as many people employing them in positive (or at least neutral ways), and because I would argue that in some ways they help regulate the game's virtual society.

When you're never 100% sure who you're talking to, perhaps you speak with a little more forethought. And when you're never 100% sure of someone's identity, maybe you're a bit more careful of who you play with.

Online we are all shapeshifters, able to switch forms on a whim regardless of whether we actually choose to do so. And like it or not, alts will forever shape our virtual loves and relationships.

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
Modern Beach House





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Psychology of the Switch

Are you dominant or submissive? Maybe you're both. By Brianne

In my first virtual BDSM relationship, I was a submissive dating a dominant man who loved the idea of restraining me. He's leave me in a cage for hours at a time, only letting me out for sex, and pretty much treated me as his personal fuck pet. This turned me on, too, and for the majority of our relationship I was more than happy with my extremely submissive role.

If you need some inspiration, here are a few ideas to get you started:


- Trying a different position during sex where the sub is on top and in control.



How To Organize a Gangbang

Ten simple steps to the most intense cybersex of your life.

I'm going to begin this article with full disclosure: I have never—either in RL or virtually—experienced a gangbang. I've partaken in numerous orgies (over 70 in fact), as well as several key parties and similar sexual events, but never was it just me and a group of men.

So what, you may quite fairly ask, qualifies me to pen this article?

The answer is that I've organized quite a few gangbangs for various friends, and from those experiences I've figured out a pretty good method of ensuring everyone has a great time.

Step One: Don't Organize Your Own Gangbang

Organizing your own gangbang is a bit like planning your own birthday party. Yeah, you could do it, but it really takes away a huge amount of joy from the event. Gangbangs are meant to be intense sexual experiences in which you can simply let go and enjoy the sensation of just being... fucked. The last thing you want to deal with is planning the guest list and contingencies, and on the big night having the stress of cancelations, late arrivals, coordination and organization.

So the first thing you need to do is find a trusted and responsible friend, hand them this article, and ask them nicely to arrange the night for you.

Step Two: The Guest List

Let's assume the girl who would like to have her brains fucked out has listened to my first piece of advice, and that you're her new gangbang organizer. What you need to do before anything else is sit down with the person whose event you're organizing and get as big a list as possible of men she'd be comfortable with.

There's two reasons why this is important. Firstly,



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you're unlikely to get *everyone* on the list there. Some guys won't be into it. Some will have scheduling conflicts. Some will have something happen last minute and won't turn up.

Secondly, it's very important you don't make assumptions as to who the gangbangee is going to be okay with. For example, there may be a man or two in her social circle which she only tolerates because they're friends of friends. There may be one who she views more like a father or big brother than a sexual partner. There might be someone who she really likes, but who she feels might not have the right temperament for that kind of sharing.

Try your best to get a list of at least ten or so names, but more is always better.

Step Three: Figure Out a Theme

I know this might surprise some people, but gangbangs come in a variety of forms. Some are incredibly dark and dirty, with the gangbangee being fucked within an inch of her life in some back alley, while others are all silk and rose petals, with the girl being erotically worshipped like a goddess. Some girls dream of just being taken, surrendering absolutely to the lust of both the men and herself, while others want the experience to be playful, a group of friends sharing a special night with her body as the entertainment.

In short, make sure you get a very clear idea as to what your gangbangee desires.

Step Four: Ready the Room

If the gangbangee can provide you with a room file she likes, that's ideal. If you're a good builder, then you can make one. But if you're mediocre at it (like me), and the girl doesn't have a room in mind, then approach someone with skills and ask for help.

Whatever the case, it's very important that the room is ready *before* you invite anyone. Wouldn't be great to have the group ready to go and have nowhere to head to.

Step Five: Set the Date

Before you approach anyone on your potential guest list, you're going to want to set a day and time that is *absolutely* going to work for the gangbangee. The last thing you want is her not showing up and you left in a room full of less than delighted gangbangers.

The date is also important because as you go through the guest list you want to make it as easy as possible for the guys to say yes or no, avoiding any confusion or misunderstandings. You want to be able to walk up to a guy on your list and have the conversation go like this...

You: Hi there John. I'm organizing a gangbang for Jane, and your name is on the list of men she'd like to have there. The event is on Saturday, December 21st at 5 pm Pacific Standard Time. Can you make it?

John: Yes. Yes I can.

You: Awesome. I'll be sure to remind you closer to the date, and if for any reason you can't make it let me know, okay?

John: Okay.

Simple and straightforward. That's how things need to be.

Step Six: Invite the Guys... 30 Minutes Early

Why do you want the men there early? Because, guaranteed, some of them are going to be late. Someone will get stuck in traffic, or have to sit though an unexpected update or something else will happen which puts them behind schedule. If you have no extra time allotted then your stress level is going to go through the roof.

Step Seven: Organize the Gangbangers

As the guys arrive, have them get into group chat with you and say the following:

All sex at this gangbang is going to happen in local chat, but you need to stay in group chat at all times. We want to create a really special experience for (insert gangbangee's name here), and that means you need to follow directions without her being aware they're being given.

We're going to start out with me picking two of you at random, while the rest of you gather around her. Those two guys are going to have 20 minutes to play with her, at which point it'll be the turn of the next two guys, and so on. I will time things for you and let you know when you have five minutes left.

We will keep going like this till either you're all spent, or she can't go any more.

This may sound very staged, and yes, it is. But it's a heck of a lot better than some guy getting angry about another gangbanger taking forever, or the men messaging over each other, or worse yet having them start fighting over the gangbangee.

And keep in mind, the lucky girl at the centre of the action won't be hearing any of this. For her it'll just be a seamless experience, which is exactly what you want for her.



Step Eight: Stick With the Script

Simply do exactly what you said you were going to do. As two guys start, pick two more who haven't had a turn yet and let them know they're next. Keep track of time and, if you get the chance, snap some pictures!

When everyone knows what to expect things will go very smoothly, and the stress level will be kept to a minimum.

Step Nine: Don't Panic

Yes, little things are bound to go wrong.

One of your guests who said he'd be there won't show up. The gangbangee will be five minutes late. Someone's controls will glitch in the middle of the action and they'll need to re-enter.

The worst thing you can do is lose your cool, especially as you're the one orchestrating this event. Just remember...





Step Ten: Thank the Guys

For the men who participate in gangbangs there's a lot of fun to be had, but there's also a fair bit of waiting around, to say nothing of them arranging their schedule to make it happen in the first place.

Make sure either you or the gangbangee (ideally the gangbangee) send them each a gift thanking them for being there. Doing so is not only courteous, but will make it easier to get them back if you ever need to organize another such event.
